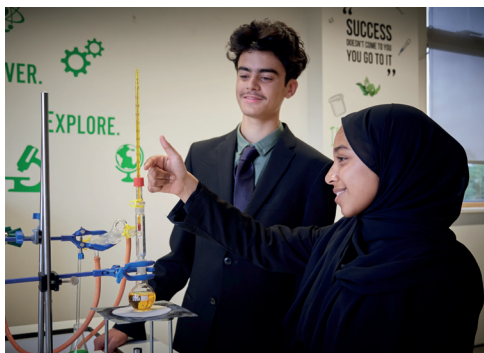

At Oaks Park we believe that all students should have access to opportunities that will allow them to apply for the most competitive careers and courses.

Our bespoke Super Curriculum programmes ensure that students gain the knowledge and skills viewed as desirable by leading companies and universities. These include the unique lecture series delivered by internationally recognised individuals from academia and industry, mentoring and volunteering opportunities within the school and local community, and university-led programmes to support students with their transition to higher education.

Our strong relationship with both The University of Oxford and Cambridge means that all Oxbridge applicants receive personalised assistance on the application process, including personal statement support, entry exam support and interview preparation. Future medics receive advice and guidance from the very start of Year 12

so they are able to make the most competitive applications to these popular courses. As well as our strong partnerships with many universities, our partnership with Amazing Apprenticeships means that all students can gain support with Apprenticeship applications as well.

Being part of Oak's Park Sixth Form also means that students will be able to access our award winning careers programme and receive extensive careers advice. All students are aided in applying for a work experience placement relevant to their desired career, something that is now a requirement of leading apprenticeship providers and universities. 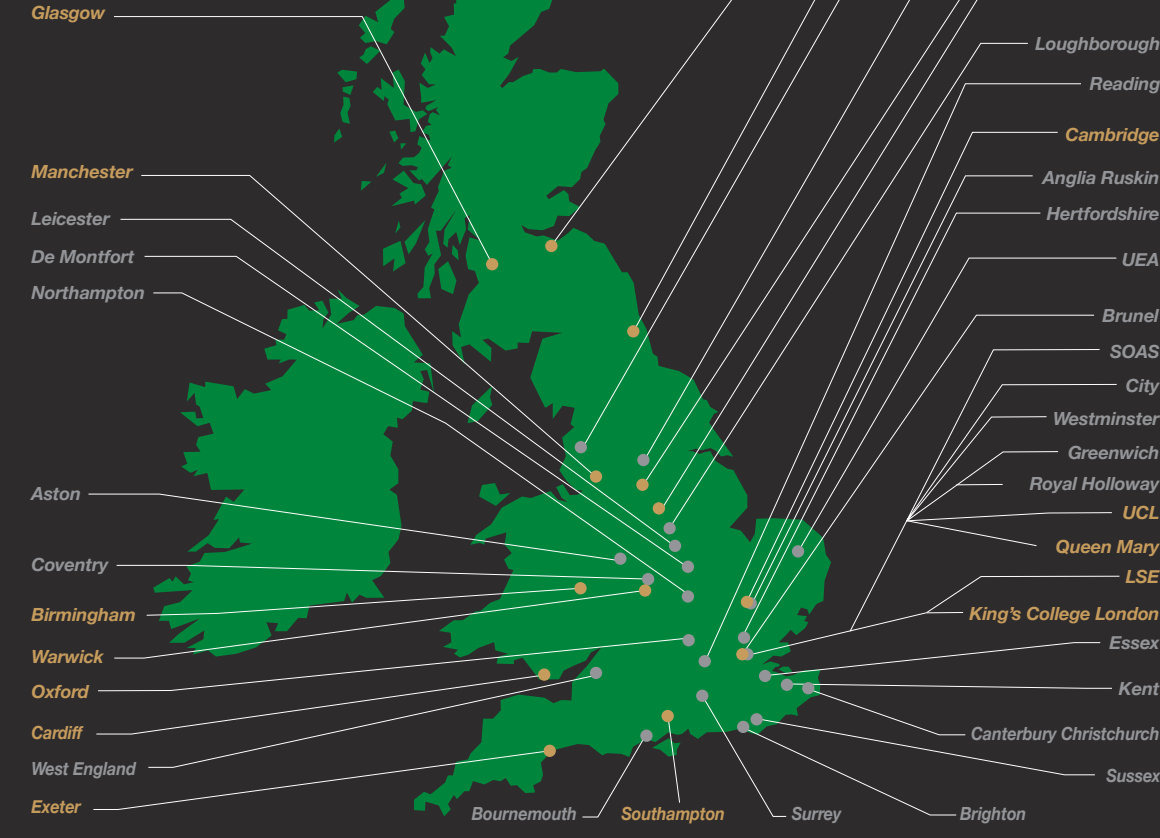


University Destinations

During the 2025 cycle, 90% of students who applied through the UCAS went on to study university courses, with 18% of students being placed at Russell Group universities. All students from Year 13 went onto a known destination, with a number gaining places on prestigious apprenticeship courses with leading firms such as Amazon, Sky and Deloitte.
